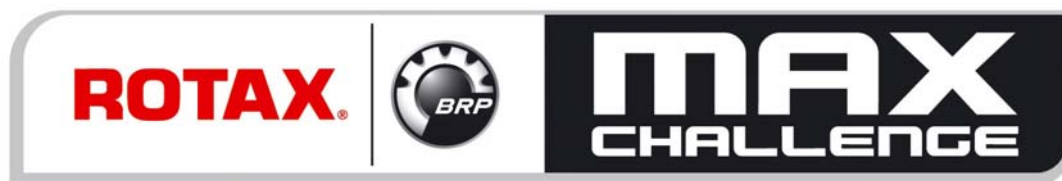

2012 KARTSTARS ROTAX MAX CHALLENGE OF NZ

MISSION STATEMENT:

To encourage kart racing drivers in New Zealand to participate in a kart series that promotes exciting, affordable and safe motorsport. To continually improve the NZ Rotax Max Challenge (NZRMC) to provide a premier series for New Zealand Residents and members of KartSport New Zealand.

PROMOTER:

The ROTAX MAX Challenge is organised by authorised Promoters in each country.

SERIES OVERALL PRIZES:

- Drivers, who qualify via their respective national ROTAX MAX Challenge, will be invited by the ROTAX Kart Centre to the Grand Finals of the ROTAX MAX Challenge to be held in November 2012, Venue and date TBA.
- **Rotax Max Light.** The winner will be invited to the 2012 RMCGF to contest the Senior Max class. Rotax and its sponsors will pay for the selected driver's kart, engine, tyres (wet and dry), and fuel for racing. Any additional benefits/prizes will be announced later.
- In addition, provisional upon New Zealand being able to send more than one senior competitor, the 2nd placed Rotax Max Light N.Z. competitor from the 2012 NZRMC will be invited to the 2012 RMCGF to contest either the Senior, or the DD2 class. Rotax and its sponsors, will pay for the selected driver's kart, engine, tyres (wet and dry), and fuel for racing. Any additional benefits/prizes will be announced later.
- **Rotax Max Junior.** The winner will be invited to the 2012 RMCGF to contest the Junior Max class. Rotax and its sponsors, will pay for the selected drivers kart, engine, tyres (wet and dry), and fuel for racing. Any additional benefits/prizes will be announced later.
- **Rotax Max Heavy.** There will be a Major Prize draw for all competitors who compete at a minimum of 4 of the six rounds, this prize will be announced at the first round.
- **Rotax Max Masters.** Rotax will have a class at the 2012 Grand Final for the Masters Class. This is for drivers who turn 32 or older during 2012. The winner of the NZ Masters class may be invited to compete in this class. The NZ driver will be selected from the Rotax Heavy class entrants, who have their 32nd or older birthday during 2012. This prize will be confirmed before close of entry.
- A trackside podium prizegiving will be held at each Round for the first three drivers in each class in the Finals.
- A prizegiving will be held in the clubrooms immediately after teching is completed at each Round.

Series Overall Prize – To be eligible competitors must have competed at 5 of the 6 rounds and have been entered into the series by the 13th February 2012 as per the entry form.

Product Prizes - All product prizes will be presented at the final Round Prizegiving at Rotorua. All product prizes will be drawn at random. To be able to collect a product prize you must have contested 4 of the 6 Rounds.

- Series trophies will be presented to 6th place
RMC Light 1st to 6th. RMC Heavy 1st to 6th RMC Junior 1st to 6th
- Round trophies will be presented to 3rd place and to the highest placed over 32
RMC Light 1st to 3rd. RMC Heavy 1st to 3rd RMC Junior 1st to 3rd

THE NUMBER OF INVITED DRIVERS MAY BE SUBJECT TO CHANGE, AT SHORT NOTICE, BEFORE OR AFTER THE REGISTRATION DATE.

NEW ZEALAND ROTAX MAX CHALLENGE 2012 SUPPLEMENTARY RULES

Series Permit Number: 1206SP

STATUS OF THE CHALLENGE:

The New Zealand Rotax Max Challenge (NZRMC) will be run as a series of Group E events, sanctioned by KartSport New Zealand. The NZRMC Rounds will be held at KartSport facilities in New Zealand, as per the Entry Form, and as such are subject to any further Supplementary Rules that the host clubs may have pertaining to their round.

1. GENERAL RULES:

For the NZRMC the Regulations, Codes, Rules, Procedures and Specifications of KartSport New Zealand are in force as are the Supplementary Rules published by the host clubs and these Supplementary Rules published by the Rotax Kart Centre and the Promoter.

Where circumstances arise which are not, or are alleged not, to be provided for in the rules of the NZRMC, they shall be determined by a joint decision between the KartSport New Zealand National Steward and one or both of the Promoter and the Rotax Kart Centre.

2. NZRMC CLASSES & ROUNDS:

- ROTAX MAX JUNIOR
- ROTAX MAX LIGHT
- ROTAX MAX HEAVY

Round 1 - 18 February	KartSport Manawatu
Round 2 - 14/15 April	KartSport Tokoroa
Round 3 - 5/6 May	KartSport Hamilton
Round 4 - 28/29 July	KartSport Bay Of Plenty
Round 5 - 25/26 August	KartSport Auckland
Round 6 - 6/7 October	KartSport Rotorua

The last round of the NZRMC will be hosted by KartSport Rotorua. Only those competitors who have entered and completed qualifying at three previous rounds of the 2012 Series will be eligible to compete in their respective NZRMC class at this Round. The NZRMC Prizegiving will be held at the conclusion of technical inspection on Sunday 7th October 2012.

3. ENTRY FORMS:

All competitors must complete the host Club's entry form for each Round and pay the appropriate fees to the host Club by the appropriate date. Only those drivers who have registered for the NZRMC will be able to compete in Rounds of the NZRMC.

An Information Sheet for the next Round will be available at confirmation of entry at Rounds 1-2. It is the competitor's responsibility to obtain it. There may be a charge for a tent/trailer site and/or a practice fee. This will be determined by the host Clubs respectively.

REGISTRATION & PROMOTION FORMS:

All NZRMC competitors must complete the Registration Form and Promotion Sheet attached to these rules and return them to the Promoter to arrive no later than **13th February 2012**.

REGISTRATION FEE:

For 2011, the NZRMC Series Overall registration fee for all classes is \$400.00.

Payable no later than **13th February 2012**.

Round Only & Product Prize Eligibility Fees will decrease throughout the series.

Round 2 = \$350. A competitor cannot enter the series after round 2.

Payment must accompany the Registration Form.

3A. ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for series points and the series prizes a competitor must be a resident in New Zealand and hold a KartSport New Zealand Licence with a minimum B Sprint Rating throughout the series. Australian Karting Association Licence holders with a valid Trans Tasman visa A or B AKA Sprint rating or holders of a CIK-FIA International Kart licence with a valid International Visa and International rating A, B, C or C Junior may take part in a series round or rounds but are not eligible for any series points or prizes. Such competitors will be treated as a technical disqualification as per Rule P1.10 when determining points for the series.

4. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS RMCGF:

Drivers competing at the Finals must obtain a CIK-FIA International “C” Licence from KartSport New Zealand. These will only be issued to NZ resident drivers holding a KartSport New Zealand “A” Sprint rating. Selected drivers are required to have an International C Licence, ASN Visa, current passport and any country visa’s, etc required to travel to the host country. To be eligible to compete at the senior RMCGF the driver(s) must have had their 15th birthday during 2012. To be eligible to compete at the Junior RMCGF, Junior drivers must have had at least their 13th birthday during 2012 and not have had their 17th birthday before 31-12-2012.

5. EVENT FORMAT

As per KartSport New Zealand Manual including National & Island Sprint Format – P1- P1.10

In the event of a total timing equipment failure at following Round grids for the heats (and Repechage) will be based on series points to date.

RACE DISTANCE: Heats: 10 km minimum. Pre-Final: 15 km minimum. Final: 20 km minimum. The Promoter and the Host Club, depending on time restrictions, may amend these distances. The Promoter and Host Club’s decision is final.

6. SERIES POINTS – All Classes:

DQ – Pre Final. No NZRMC Points awarded.

DQ – Final. No NZRMC points awarded. If for a technical infringement a competitor is removed from the results and all competitors move up. NZRMC Points for other competitors who contested the Pre-Final and Final only will be adjusted accordingly.

Ties - Eg 1st equal: both get 53.5 points.

Where competitors are tied on points at the end of the NZRMC Series, ties will be decided as follows:

- Winner of the most Round Finals wins.
- If still equal, the competitor who finished in front in the Final at Round 6 wins.
- If still equal, by a decision made in accordance with **General Rules** above.

POINTS SYSTEM

Pre-Final Points: 34, 33, 32, 31 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, etc place. Non-starters in the Pre-Final will be awarded NZRMC points equal to last place, minus one (-1)

Final points: 55, 52, 50, 49, 48, - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, etc place. Non-starters in the Final will be awarded NZRMC points equal to last place, minus one (-1)

SERIES OVERALL RESULTS (All Classes)

Will be drivers best performance from 5 of the 6 rounds, ie only 5 of the 6 rounds count (a driver who only competes in 5 of the 6 rounds will have all 5 rounds counted).

A DQ from any round cannot be dropped as a worst performance, the next worst round result will be the round which is dropped.

7. TECHNICAL & CHASSIS REGULATIONS

1. NZRMC ENGINE: ROTAX FR125 MAX:

The engine and its ancillaries may not be modified in any way and must conform to KartSport New Zealand Rules and Specifications.

2. NZRMC ROTAX MAX LIGHT KART SPECIFICATIONS:

As per KartSport New Zealand Rules. Dry tyre: MOJO D2. Wet tyre: As per KartSport New Zealand Rules.

3. NZRMC ROTAX MAX HEAVY KART SPECIFICATIONS:

As per KartSport New Zealand Rules. Tyres as per KartSport New Zealand Rules.

4. NZRMC ROTAX JUNIOR CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:

As per KartSport New Zealand Class Rule 125cc Rotax Max Junior (reference E3.15 in 2011 Manual). Tyres as per KartSport New Zealand Rules.

I declare that should I at the time of this event be suffering from any disability of any kind whether permanent or temporary which is likely to detrimentally affect my control of my kart or my fitness to drive, I will not participate.

I declare that I will not make use of drugs or of prohibited methods such as are defined by the Intoxicating Liquor and Drug regulations of KartSport New Zealand.

I declare that I give consent to the details contained on this entry form being held by KartSport New Zealand and/or the Organising Club for the purpose of the promotion and benefit of the event concerned, and KartSport in general.
